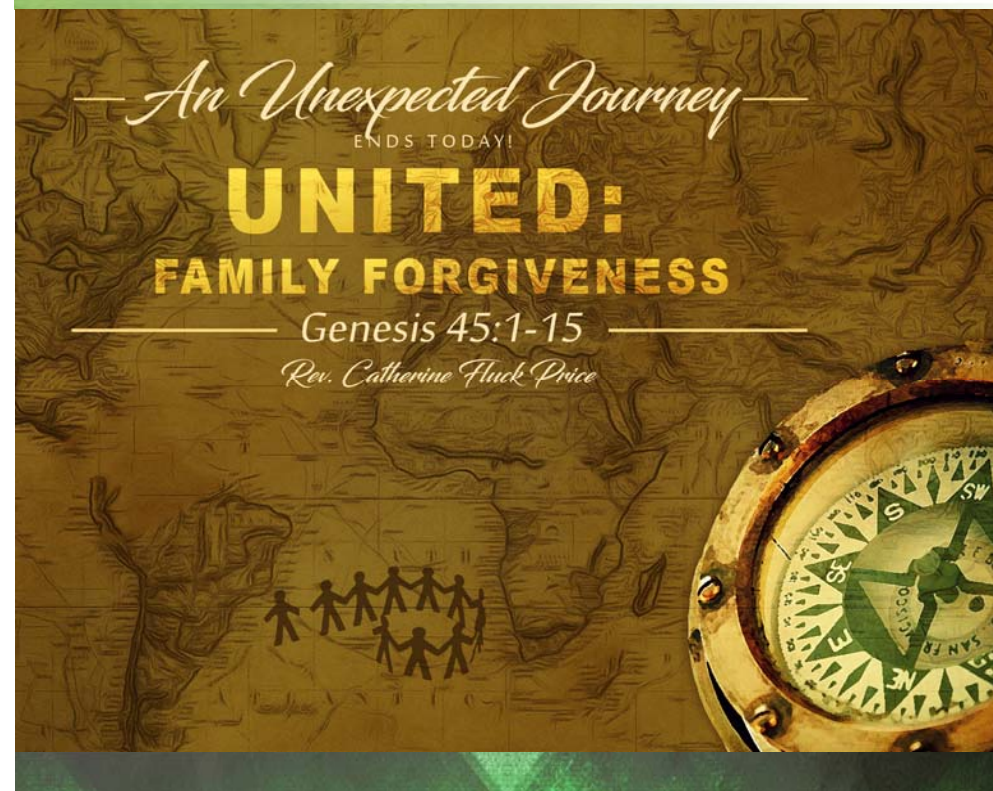

Glimpses of God: Finding God in the Stories We Tell Our Children

Jesus said to the disciples: "Allow the children to come to me....I assure you that whoever doesn't welcome God's kingdom like a child will never enter it."
